Yvonne Jones, LCSW is the director of Adult Forensic Behavioral Health (AFBH)/Conditional Release Program (CONREP) and the Court mental health programs, (Court Advocacy Program and Behavioral Health Court). She has been working in the Criminal Justice system for over 28 years primarily in mental health. Yvonne started as a clinician in mental health at Santa Rita Jail in 1994 and worked there providing clinical assessments, intakes and crisis intervention until 2001. At that time she moved to the CONREP as a case manager, working closely with Millie Swafford the former director of AFBH, and in 2004 became the CONREP program supervisor. In November of 2013 Yvonne was appointed as the director of CJMH/CONREP. Prior to her work in Alameda County she worked in the County Jail in Santa Clara County in Substance Recovery/Re-Entry programs. She has many years of providing direct services to the mentally ill in correctional facilities, working closely with the court systems and the State Hospitals.
